

Responsible Adult Childcare Worker – On call, part-time

Qualifications:

- Be of good character and have the personality, ability, and temperament necessary to work with children
- A minimum of a Responsible Adult Course (at least 20 hours in duration or combination of course in child development, guidance, health and safety, or nutrition)
- An Immigrant Childminding Orientation Certificate (a 12 hour course designed by Westcoast Resource Centre if have less than 1500 hours experience working with immigrant children within the last 3 years)
- A criminal record check clearance letter from the Ministry of Public safety and Solicitor General's office
- Physician's report confirming good physical health and emotional stability
- A valid 8 hour emergency Child Care First Aid Certificate
- A Food Safe Certificate
- Evidence of compliance with the Province's Immunization standards
- Be of at least 19 years of age
- Have relevant work experience and proven ability to work closely with other team members
- An additional language would be an asset
- Be culturally sensitive to newcomer immigrant children and their parents

Reports to: Childminding Program Supervisor

Core Duties:

- Work with childminding staff to carry out appropriate activities that promote the well-being of each child and that respect and reflect the diverse needs of children
- In collaboration with the Childminding Manager and other staff, ensure that all individual plans that recognize differences are reviewed and revised as needed
- Follow behaviour guidance policies established by the centre and consistent with ***ChildCare Licensing Regulation***
- Work with childminding team to ensure the child care environment is healthy and safe for all children
- Ensure positive communication with the parents of children taking into consideration language differences
- Contribute to the on-going operation of the childminding centre by being aware of and following Childcare Licensing Regulation
- Participate in professional development and attend staff meetings
- Maintain confidentiality regarding information related to the children, families, and personnel
